




Writing poems was a popular activity for passengers on the *SS Great Britain,* with many creating their own and sharing them in onboard newspapers and concerts.


Passengers often wrote about things that were affecting them during the voyage, with poems about love, the journey and missing home proving popular topics. One passenger even wrote one about their missing hat!

- Pick one of the words on the following pages and write an acrostic poem.




