



Brunel's Curiosity Quest

Use this Curiosity Quest to explore Being Brunel and discover more about the great engineer, Isambard Kingdom Brunel.



- I. Cut or tear across the dotted line.
- II. With the blank side facing up, fold and unfold in half in both directions. Then fold each corner into the middle.
- III. Turn over so the tasks face up and fold each corner into the middle.
- IV. Fold it in half to make a rectangle and then fold it in half again to make a square.
- V. Unfold back to a rectangle and then put your thumbs and index fingers into the four pockets on the outside of the rectangle. Push together.
- VI. Pinch and push the corners as you spell out one of the words.
- VII. Repeat when you count out your chosen number.
- VIII. Chose a final number and lift the flap to find your challenge.

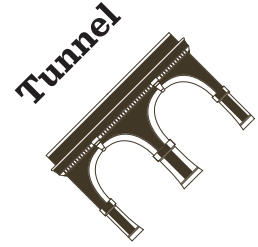
