

How to Make a Cornucopia Tree Decoration


You will need:

15cm x 15cm square of coloured card.
Ribbon
Ruler
Glue stick
Scissors
Hole Punch
Colouring pencils or felt tip pens


Method

- 1. Decorate your 15 x 15cm square of coloured card. You could do festive images or a pattern.
- 2. Roll your square into a cone shape





- 3. Glue down one side so that the cone keeps its 3D shape.
- 4. Use a hole punch to carefully punch two holes on either side of the open part of the cone. Make sure the holes are not too close to the top to prevent it from ripping.



- 5. Cut a piece of ribbon 40cm long, this will be used to hang up your cornucopia.
- 6. Thread your ribbon through both holes and tie it securely in a knot.
- 7. Hang it on your Christmas tree. You could fill it with your favourite treats like the Victorians would have done.
